
It can be scary when someone is seriously hurt or very, very sick. This book will show you what to do when you need help fast.




## If you see someone who is hurt, call 911.



## If someone is in trouble and needs help, call 911.




### If you see a car crash, call 911.

What is your name?


What is the address you are at now?

What is the phone number where you are at now?




## Match the 911 helpers by drawing a line to how they would come to help you.

#### Police Officer






